SUBJECT: Warfel Construction Company begins \$12.3 million school project

East Petersburg, PA, September 29, 2009 – Warfel Construction Company recently began construction on the Eisenhower Elementary School Campus and Grace Milliman Pollock Performing Arts Center for the Camp Hill School District. For students in grades 3 to 5, much of the existing Eisenhower Elementary will be demolished and rebuilt featuring state-of-the-art science labs, library, gymnasium, and additional classrooms. The new performing arts center on the campus will house a specially designed 500 seat theater and an outside amphitheater for events and instruction. Space for visual arts, dance, choral and instrumental instruction, as well as theatre amenities such as space for set construction, dressing rooms, a green room, ticket booth, and cloak room will also be included.

Overseeing the project for Warfel is Project Manager Brett Calabretta, and Superintendent Wayne Shroyer, both of Lancaster. The project, designed by Crabtree Rohrbaugh Associates of Harrisburg, is expected to take 17 months to build with completion scheduled for mid-December 2010.
